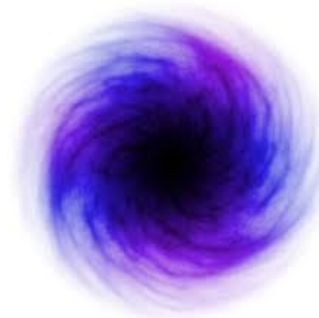
The inter-class Tug of War was held in between the sprint semi finals and finals. These results are also shown.
