

Check your Class Dojo!

The Class Dojo is your parent portal to what is happening in your child's class and team. The newsletter is good for giving 'whole school' information; however, it doesn't work so well when different teams/classes have different things they want to say. This is where the Dojo comes into play. Team and Class news will be posted here. Make sure you keep in touch by checking in.

Let us know before you go!!

Every year we have pupils and their families going on extended leave (more than five days) during term time. This is usually for family holidays. While we don't endorse the practice, we recognise that it happens. The thing is... You

have to let us know (in writing) what is happening.

It's not enough to just 'tell the teacher' or 'tell the office.' We need to know, in writing:

- Child's name and room number
- ➤ First date of absence
- Date of returning to school (very important)
- ➤ Reason for absence

Without this information, the Ministry of Education will expect us to **remove a child from the school roll** after a certain number of days of absence. That means that on return, you would have to re-enrol your child, assuming they are eligible for enrolment. Don't let this happen - let us know before you go!

Road Safety reminder

We thank the vast majority of our parents who make sure their **children cross Everglade Drive at the pedestrian crossing.** It is so vital that children learn that this is the safe way to cross, and it is important that they are not taught to just duck across the road when Mum or Dad call them. It takes an extra minute or two, but it is worth it.
