

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- 1** POUR MILK INTO A MEDIUM SAUCEPAN AND HEAT OVER LOW HEAT UNTIL WARM. STIR OCCASIONALLY WITH THE WHISK.
- 2** FILL THE SMALL SAUCEPAN AROUND 1/3 OF THE WAY FULL WITH WATER AND BRING TO A BOIL.
- 3** WHEN THE WATER BOILS, PLACE THE GLASS BOWL ON TOP OF THE SMALL SAUCEPAN AND PUT THE CHOCOLATE INTO THE BOWL.
- 4** WHEN THE CHOCOLATE BEGINS TO MELT, STIR IT WITH THE SPOONULA.
- 5** POUR THE CHOCOLATE INTO THE MILK. USE THE SPOONULA TO HELP SCRAPE THE CHOCOLATE OFF THE SIDES OF THE BOWL.
- 6** HOLD ON TO THE HANDLE OF THE SAUCEPAN WHILE YOU WHISK THE MILK AND CHOCOLATE TOGETHER.
- 7** POUR INTO A MUG AND ALLOW TO COOL SLIGHTLY BEFORE ENJOYING.

OR TRY THIS!
MAKE A WHITE HOT CHOCOLATE USING WHITE CHOCOLATE INSTEAD OF MILK CHOCOLATE!

- Milk
- 3/4 CUP MILK
- WATER FOR MELTING THE CHOCOLATE
- 1/2 OUNCE MILK CHOCOLATE
