We are closing in on the end of the most unusual school term in memory. At this stage, we are moving closer to full normal, while recognising that our new normal is both the same and different to the previous version.

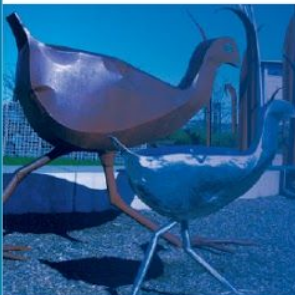

Now it's time to catch up on **one of our ex-pupils**.

You may remember last year I wrote about **Sarpreet Singh**, who attended Everglade School through his primary school years.

Sarpreet was a passionate and highly skilled football player, who became a professional footballer with the Wellington Phoenix, playing in the Australian A-League competition. His play for the Phoenix, and for the New Zealand Under-20 team saw him signed by Bayern Munich, the German super team who are one of the strongest football teams in the world. In the last twelve months, Sarpreet has trained and played for Bayern Munich. Originally signed to a 'reserve team' contract, he made his way into the senior team squad, and has played several times in the German football championship, known as the Bundesliga.



Last week Bayern Munich won the Bundesliga for the eighth consecutive season. The Bundesliga is rated as being equivalent to the English Premier League, as one of the top four competitions in Europe. You can imagine the standard of any team that can be champions for eight seasons in a row, and the standard of play that Sarpreet has attained to be part of this team.

We congratulate Sarpreet Singh on his footballing achievements, and wish him further success in his future football career.
