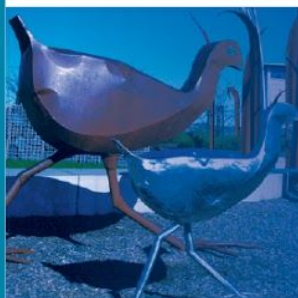
Dear Parents/Caregivers,

My monster is a vampire. His hair is golden because he likes to be shiny. My monster likes to play soccer with me. My monster's name is puffy. It is blue and has big eyes.

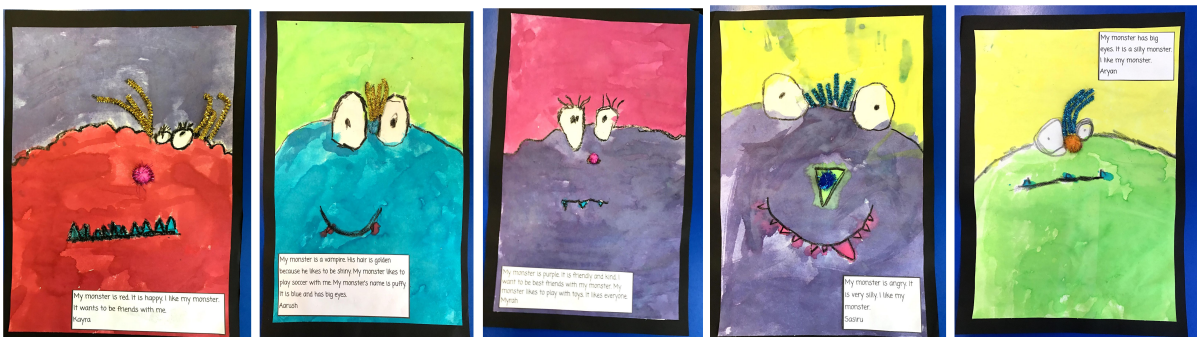
