#### **Teacher Only Days**

The Ministry of Education has allocated several Teacher Only Days to schools. These are for the purpose of continuing to upskill teachers in curriculum and learning approaches, or pedagogy. The days are to be used from 2020 to mid-2022. Because of the situation this year, we have postponed two of our scheduled Teacher Only Days.

We have now rescheduled TWO TEACHER ONLY DAYS into the Term Four programme. These are on Friday 23 October and Friday 20 November. School will be closed on those days.

A full overview of Term Four will be published at the start of next term. Start date for the term is Monday 12 October, and the last day of the year is Tuesday 15 December.
