Dear Parents/Caregivers,

Our newest class opened yesterday.


Room Five began as a full time classroom yesterday. Five year old children who start school this term will begin their schooling in this room. We already have 9 pupils after the first day, and we expect this to grow to about 18 by the end of term.

The teachers for the class are Mrs Quickfall and Mrs Kitzen, who have both worked at Everglade School previously.

At Level One, all pupils are expected to be attending school. This doesn't mean that your child may not be sick one day, and unable to come to school.

Please remember that if your child is unable to attend school, **you need to let us know.** The easiest way to do this is through the **SKOOL LOOP APP.**

Getting through the Gates

Our new internal gate system is almost fully installed. There are a few minor tasks and tidy up jobs before it is finished later this week.

From Monday 19 October, the gates will be operational. Please note how the process works.

In the morning:

The gates will be opened by staff members early each morning (by 8.00am.) All gates can be used to enter the school.

At 9.00am, these gates will be closed (locked) until 2.45pm. Access to school during this time is via the Office corridor only (through the Atrium, and down the corridor.)

In the afternoon:

At 2.45pm, the gates will be opened, and will remain open until the end of the day. They will then be locked overnight from about 4.30pm.

This week is a 'test week' for the system, so if you find the gates locked during the day, just head down through the Office corridor.
