
Due to the Alert Level changes, we have postponed our Parent Orientation Sessions. These are now as follows:

A different opportunity...

One of the services funded by the Ministry of Education is a community-based Attendance Officer service. In the greater Manurewa area/cluster of schools, there is an Attendance Officer service operating. The Manurewa Attendance Service has a vacancy, and schools are displaying the advertisement. Please check this out below.

MANUREWA ATTENDANCE SERVICE ATTENDANCE OFFICER ADVERTISEMENT.

To commence as soon as possible, or thereabouts, the Manurewa Attendance Service Cluster is seeking to appoint an Attendance Officer (AO) who is passionate about inclusive education to help students, aged 5 to 16 years, who are presenting irregular attendance behaviour and have disengaged from school, to attend school. This is a part time position during the school term time only. Work hours will be 28 hour per week and the pay rate is \$35.00/hour. It is expected that the days/hours will be worked as follows:

- 8.00am 12.00, Monday, Tuesday and Friday,
 8.00a.m. 4.30p.m. Wednesday and Thursday)

Work use of a cell phone, laptop and vehicle will be provided.

The Manurewa Attendance Service Cluster is divided into three hubs, with between 9-12 schools in each hub. Currently the Attendance Officers are based across the hubs as follows:

Manurewa Central Hub 2 x Attendance Officers (based at Manurewa Intermediate) 1 x Attendance Officer (Based at Greenmeadows Intermediate) Manurewa East Hub Manurewa West Hub 1 x Attendance Officer (Based at Weymouth Primary)

This AO will be located at Greenmeadows Intermediate School, but will work across all three hubs, depending on where the need is. They will be employed by Greenmeadows Intermediate School, through the Cluster Lead Principal.

To be considered for these positions applicants will have:

- High levels of cultural responsiveness
- Highly effective communication skills
- Strong relational management skills
- Strong organisation and self-management skills and aptitudes
- High personal effectiveness
- Ability to build community
- A qualification in youth work, social work (or at least extensive experience in a related field)
- Meet the requirements of the Children's Act 2014 in order to work with students and their families/whanau
- A full, clean and current NZ Driver Licence
