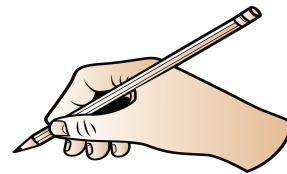
About 90% of our pupils have paid the Visiting Performer Charge for 2021, so are already booked for this show.
