#### **Three Way Conferences**

**Bookings for today's 3WCs will close today at 12.30pm**. The app remains open for you to book a 3WC for next Thursday 01 July.

If you have booked for a 3WC today, please make sure you arrive before time, as these are tightly scheduled.

If you haven't booked yet, then when the app re-opens tomorrow you can book for Thursday 01 July.

#### Arriving at school

**Classes begin at 8.55am**, and all pupils should be at school by this time. Pupils who are late must report to the office and 'sign in.'

Unless they are attending Kids Club, **pupils should not arrive at school before 8.00am** each morning. They are then required to sit outside their rooms until the 8.30 bell rings. This then allows them to go into class, put their bags in the cloak room etc.

#### Leaving school

When classes finish at 3.00pm, most pupils walk home or are picked up. A few have to wait a bit longer for their pick up to arrive.

We expect all pupils to be picked up by 3.15pm. At this stage (when the Road Patrol Monitors come off duty) any pupils waiting by the gate must go to wait outside the Library. As the vehicle gates open, parents can drive in, park and get out of their cars to collect their children.

Do not expect your child to wait at the gate, or by the carpark, if you arrive after 3.15pm.

At the very latest, all pupils should be picked up by 3.30pm

Please note that from 3.15pm we do not provide direct supervision of pupils who are waiting outside the Library. Teachers may pass by and remind children to be seated, but no one is 'on duty' from 3.15pm

Please use the following table to check who your first contact should be when you have a concern about your child.

If your concern is about	Please contact
A Classroom Matter	Your child's teacher (see Note 1 below)
An unresolved Classroom Matter	See Note 2 below
Attendance Matters	Mrs Powrie
Playground Behaviour Matters	Mrs Roberts
Student Welfare (Pastoral Care) Matters	Mr Robinson
Special Needs or Educational Programme Support	Mrs Naidoo
School Operations and Policy Matters	Mr Robinson

Note 1: Sometimes a classroom matter will arise when the regular teacher is not in the class. It is still expected that you contact the class teacher. They will then pursue the matter

Note 2: If you have discussed a classroom matter with your child's teacher, and you feel it has not been resolved or concluded, please ask at the office to speak with either:

One of the Deputy Principals, Mrs Roberts or Mrs Powrie

or the Principal, Mr Robinson

Whoever is available will then meet with you
