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As we start the third term, it is a good opportunity to **promote our school uniform.** Like many schools, we have a uniform, and our pupils are expected to wear it daily. We take pride in the appearance of our pupils, and the standard they attain in wearing of uniform.

To maintain these standards, there are two areas that we bring to your attention.

Socks and Tights - our uniform calls for socks that are either ankle socks or just below the calf. We should not see long socks worn to school. Socks should be a neutral colour.

Children may wear tights to school. These should be either navy or black. There should be no patterns or pictures in tights worn.

Please assist by ensuring your child's socks/tights meet these requirements.

Jerseys and Jackets - we have a uniform jersey, which is a polar fleece with collar. This is the only jersey that children should wear.

THERE SHOULD BE NO SWEATSHIRTS, HOODIES, TRACKSUIT TOPS OR ANY OTHER TOPS. We find that this is our biggest uniform issue, and we need to keep on top of it.

As far as jackets go, children can either wear a school jacket, their own jacket, or a school 'Warriors' raincoat, which is almost as good as a jacket.

There is a clear difference between an item which is a jacket and one which is not. We do not expect to see sweatshirts, hoodies etc being worn and being told that these are jackets. Children will be told to take these items off.

Typically, jackets should be worn outdoors, and raincoats are definitely for outdoors only.

Again, we ask you to ensure that your child wears correct jerseys/jackets at school.

Term 3 and Term 4 Dates

Term Three started on 26 July, and ends on Friday 01 October

Term Four starts on 18 October, and ends on Tuesday 14 December
