Prizegiving Awards

For a few years now we have had a policy that any student who receives an award must be present at the Prizegiving Ceremony or the award will be discounted. With the borders closed the last couple of years, that hasn't been such an issue. Given that things have now opened up, it's timely to give this reminder.

The 'B' Word

We find from time to time that certain words become extremely popular, and get used in ways that they are not intended. One word that falls into that category is 'bullying.' There are times when bullying is a real thing, and if this is happening at school we need to hear so we can take action. It's also true that we get told about bullying when this is not an accurate description. For any behaviour to be called 'bullying' it has to meet certain conditions. The graphic below explains this quite well



When someone says or does something unintentionally hurtful and they do it once, that's **RUDE**.

When someone says or does something intentionally hurtful and they do it once, that's **MEAN**

When someone says or does something intentionally hurtful and they keep doing iteven when you tell them to stop or show them that you're upset—that's

BULLYING.

We say to our families, if something is worrying your child please let their teacher know. If necessary, it will get referred to me or a Deputy Principal. Try to avoid the 'B word' at this stage; that way, we can deal with things for what they are, and if the behaviour is bullying it can be dealt with appropriately.
